Why do you think Jesus asked the people to travel light?

Why were the disciples asked to shake the dust off their feet upon leaving a town where they were rejected?

Why do you think the disciples were not told where they would be accepted or rejected?

What did Williams Tyndale's illustration have to do with the sermon content from today?

Why are we not responsible for how people will respond to the mission of Jesus?

How does 2 Thessalonians 3:1 connect to today's sermon?

Why do you think everyone is given a choice to receive or reject the mission of Christ?
